We will conclude by answering our key question and providing evidence to support our decisions.

English

In English, we will be using the book 'When the Mountains Roared' to create newspaper articles. We will analyse different newspaper articles and look at the features to then create our own Newspaper articles.

We will then use our book as a theme for a piece of poetry work.

We will continue to have daily VIPERS sessions to support our skills of vocabulary, inference, predictions, explanations, retrieval, and summarising skills.

PSHE

This term we will be looking at Changing Me and how bodies change when they go through puberty.

Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on measuring angles using a protractor and drawing angles, as well as understanding angles in a shape.

We will then revisit time, with a focus on converting between hours and minutes to ensure fluency and ability to show reasoning.

We will then look at information in tables and charts, understanding how to create and interpret them.

We will then revisit our prior learning of multiplication and division, focusing on dividing using a formal written method.

We will continue to have daily mental maths sessions in order further develop our arithmetic skills and work on our times tables.

PE

In PE we will be focusing on batting and fielding skills with rounders and cricket.

Theology

We will be focusing on What matters most to Humanists and Christians?

Computing

In computing, we will be looking at programming and exploring how we can use it to design and create quizzes. We will then test and evaluate our quizzes.

Geography:

In geography, we will be exploring environmental features of the Lake District, the Tatra Mountains in Poland, and the Caribbean and Jamaica. We will focus on terrain, climate, population and living conditions. We will look at similarities and differences between them and understanding what makes them unique.

DT

In DT, we will be exploring textiles and creating a bag using recycled fabric. We will be exploring different fabrics and analysing the best fabric to use.

Science

In Science, we will continue to focus on forces. We will have chance to take part in lots of practical investigations that will allow us the opportunity to put our learning to the test. We will create hypothesis, conduct, and evaluate fair tests. This will also link with our DT project, which will run alongside.
