

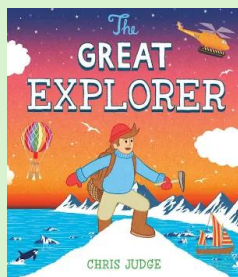
English:

To develop our writing skills, we will be using our class text to sequence and describe events. We will create a newspaper report based on our text, and a non-chronological report linked to our history work.

We will continue to focus on the features needed to be a Year two writer, learning how to apply these in different contexts.

To support the writing process, pupils will have opportunity for oral rehearsal.

In addition to this, revisiting spelling patterns and strategies will be a daily focus.



Geography:

In geography we will be comparing the physical and human geography of a small area of the UK and a small area of a contrasting non-European country – Yanomami

Art:

3D Art

To develop as Artists, we will join materials together to form a 3D work of Art. We will explore the work of different sculptors to inspire our designs.

Science:

To develop as scientists, we will be revisiting animals including humans, looking at what they need to survive, their habitats and food chains.

Maths:

As mathematicians, we will continue to build our understanding of timetables, developing fluency and speed when counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, to support our calculations and problem solving. We will be looking at measurement of time, money, capacity and temperature. As well as looking at different tables, tally charts and pictograms in statistics. Throughout our learning we will apply our mathematical knowledge to solve a range of practical problems and reasoning challenges.

Computing:
