

English:

Year Three will be reading 'The Wild Robot' by Peter Brown. They will use this to support writing a diary account of events. They will write in the first person and continue to practise using a range of conjunctions to make their piece more interesting.

After this, the class will write a non-chronological report about significant landmarks in the UK thinking about how to use heading and subheadings and other key features used when writing a report.

The class will continue to practise 10 spellings each week and handwriting skills.

Science:

Forces

Geography

To become Geographers, we will be learning about the United Kingdom. Year Three, will name the cities and countries of the UK. They will also study physical and human features that are found in England, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales.

Religion and World Views:

Maths

In Mathematics pupils will be learning about fractions where they will recognise, find and write fractions of a discrete set of objects: unit fractions and non-unit fractions with small denominators. They will then move onto three-digit addition and subtraction using regrouping and exchanging using the column method.

Art:

Year 3 will explore the range of marks that can be made through printing. They will make their own printing blocks and print on different surfaces. During this unit, they will be exploring different tools, materials and techniques to create mono-printing and block printing.
