

English:

In English, we will be using the story 'Lost and Found' to inspire our writing. We will continue to use basic skills such as capital letters, finger spaces and full stops when building sentences. We will also be extending our sentences using conjunctions such as 'and'.

Children will also have daily 'Read Write Inc' phonic sessions where they will learn a new sound each day. They will practice reading these sounds in words whilst consolidating sounds they have already learnt.



Science:

Pupils will be identifying and naming a variety of everyday materials. They will be exploring their properties and finding out which materials are waterproof. Pupils will also learn about animals and identify which animal group they belong to.

PSHE:

- Dreams and Goals –

Children will be looking at what aspirations they might have, goal setting and what they might want to improve in.

DT:

- In D&T, we will investigate structures. We will look at a range of materials and explore why they stay in place and why they may not. The children will also be looking at what makes a structure balance and how to fold.

Maths

- During this half term, children will be adding and subtracting numbers between 11 and 17.
- Children will build on their shape knowledge and identify 2-d and 3-d shapes.
- We will continue to build on number facts through repetition, singing and chanting.

Religion and world views:

- In RE children will be looking at the main question – 'What do Christians believe God is like?'

PE:

- Gymnastics
