

English:

In English, we will be using two key texts, 'Katie in London' and 'Coming to England' to inspire our writing. Children will be writing postcards and letters, describing a range of famous landmarks in London. We will sequence the stories and create story maps to create our own stories.

Children will also have daily 'Read Write Inc' phonic sessions where they will learn a new sound each day. They will practice reading these sounds in words whilst consolidating sounds they have already learnt.

Science:

In Science we will be revisiting animals and humans and the different habitats the animals live in. We will identify different features of animals.

PSHE:

- Relationships–

Children will be looking at what key relationships they have in and out of school and how to stay safe.

DT:

- In D&T, we will investigate the question 'can you make a picture move.'

Maths

- We will continue to develop our addition and subtraction skills using one- and two-digit numbers.
- Children will learn how to read a clock to the hour and half past.
- We will continue to build on number facts through repetition, singing and chanting.
- Children will learn about position and direction and highlighting their left and rights.
